Rocketry is open to grades three through five only (for safety reasons). We will meet Thursday mornings (weather permitting) at 8AM on the back ballfield. First launch is Thursday, March 15th. **Students must bring their own rockets, motors, igniters, and wadding. All rockets must be safety inspected by Mr./Ms.xxxxx prior to launch.**

There will be a required safety meeting on Thursday, March 8, at 8AM in the Serendipity Lab. Students may bring their rockets to the safety meeting for inspection.

This club is 'open' to all grade 3-5 students who have had a safety briefing and have inspected rockets. Students who are briefed may attend any launch dates they wish, whether they have rockets to launch or not.
